The grey button at the top of the Escro guidelines/templates for escro (see example below 'EScro Alcohol BI screen') replaces the old 'stand alone' toolbar which some practices were using.

Clicking on this button for the first time, you will be asked for your Vision User name / password.

The electronic screens will then open... (this may take a moment, so please be patient)

But some points to note...

Firstly, after entering information, when you save and exit, the data will not show in Vision *unless you exit the patient's record and go back in.*

This is because when you open a consultation in Vision, it will only show historical data and any data entered within the current encounter - launching the Escro screen is actually opening a separate encounter.

The other known issue we have is that when saving *any of the alcohol consumption read codes*, a pop-up will prompt you to confirm alcohol consumption details. It is important at this stage that the read code it defaults to *is not changed*.

If 136V. (Weekly consumption) is recorded; the weekly value will be in the correct field in the pop-up and just needs to be confirmed.

If 136X. (Daily alcohol consumption on heaviest drinking day) is recorded, the only designated field in the pop-up is 'Weekly'; therefore we put the daily value into the 'comments'. This is a problem with Vision and they have been made aware of it.
