

Patients Eligible for Enhanced Services

This paper summarises the patients who are eligible for Enhanced Services. These are the patients that will be picked up by the ESCRO Submission Verification tool in order that a claim can be submitted to the CHP's.

Intrauterine Contraceptive Device Fitting

Any patient registered on the practice list or temporary resident at the time of the fitting. ie patients who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

Implanon insertion and removal

Any patient registered on the practice list or temporary resident at the time of the insertion or removal. ie patients who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

Minor Injury

Any patient registered on the practice list or temporary resident at the time of the minor injury service. ie patients who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

Minor Surgery

Any patient registered on the practice list or temporary resident at the time of the minor surgery on. i.e. patients who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

Multiple Sclerosis

Any patient registered on the practice list during the financial year who has multiple sclerosis. Temporary residents are excluded. Patients who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason during the year will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

Depression

Any patient registered on the practice list during the financial year who was on the depression register for any length of time during the year. Temporary residents are excluded. Patients who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason during the year will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

Alcohol

Any patient registered on the practice list during the financial year who was on the alcohol misuse register for any length of time during the year. Temporary residents are excluded. Patients who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason during the year will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

Near Patient Testing

Any patient registered on the practice list during each quarter of year. Temporary residents are excluded. Patients who are registered with the practice during a quarter who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason during the quarter will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

If a practice provides this service to a temporary resident for a prolonged period and all the submission criteria are met a practice can choose to submit a forced claim

Anticoagulation Any patient registered on the practice list during each quarter of year. Temporary residents are excluded. Patients who are registered with the practice during a quarter who subsequently leave the practice list for any reason during the quarter will still be picked up by the claim submission tool and then a claim submitted if all the criteria for submission are met.

If a practice provides this service to a temporary resident for a prolonged period and all the submission criteria are met a practice can choose to submit a forced claim.

Patients should not be deleted from the system until any claim has been made.
