



We have now released the Escro Sexual Health module as the first cross-platform data entry screen available in the same format for both Vision and Gpass. This is being released as a beta version, and we would appreciate feed back on any areas that are not intuitive.

There are a number of options available to extract and enter information into Vision using the API (application programmers' interface). The model we have adopted follows InPS guidelines and will require you to be logged into Vision to operate. We will in a later release, provide closer integration allowing Escro to be launched from within Vision but at present the screens run as a separate application.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE VISION RUNNING ON THE DESKTOP YOU WILL BE PROMPTED TO ENTER A USER NAME/PASSWORD FOR EVERY ENTRY RECORDED.

Download and double-click on the setup file (shsetup.exe) to install, this will add an entry in the Program Files > Escro folder and place a shortcut on your desktop.

Double-click on the shortcut to launch the application, and initially you will be presented with the Vision patient browser.

As extracting the patient history is a separate process, we again require a valid Vision username/password. As this screen is not accessible without first logging into Vision, we have temporarily added the facility to save a user name/password in encrypted form as this will be required every time you launch the application.

This second user is only used for reporting, and we would recommend that in the future an “Escro” user is added to Vision who has no privileges related to the clinical system (not a member of any group)

On confirmation of the date, the main Escro screen will be launched.

The main data collection screens can be accessed by using the navigation tree on the left or by clicking on the required item on the summary grid.

When all information has been entered, clicking on "OK" will save the information to the patient's clinical record. Vision will verify every entry and in most cases will prompt where there is the option to enter further information.

As information is submitted at the end of the consultation in a batch, you may be presented with a succession of confirmation boxes. We are working to reduce these as a default recording pattern develops.
