



## Additions/Amendments – May 2012 – Highland

Please note: The new Escro “Dashboard” is now available for download (see image below). Previously, these buttons were at the top of each guideline and open the electronic screens. Practices can if they wish, continue to use the guidelines, from the Escro web site but we will no longer be amending each individual guideline

Using the new “dashboard” style guideline will remove the necessity to constantly update the “old style” escro guidelines. It makes the data entry much simpler as all the information is clearly displayed using the electronic screens. It also means administration time being saved as there will only be **one** ‘dashboard’ (with the mnemonic **@ESH**)

The Escro Dashboard (@ESH) – which replaces the list of guidelines.

- Encounter comments now work for Vision users. Comments attached to read code 9N11
