Sexual Health

Sexual health in Scotland is poor. Sexually transmitted infections such as Chlamydia, are widespread and increasing, while teenage conceptions are amongst the highest in Western Europe. Sexually transmitted infections, including HIV, affect people of all ages in Scotland, although incidence is greatest among those under 25. These infections can give rise to health complications and affect fertility, placing increasing demands on clinical services which can be prevented through the encouragement of safer sex practices.
