Minor Injury

Minor injury - enhanced service claim* and a type of injury (or an onward referral) should be recorded on the same day to fulfill the criteria for payment under this enhanced service. The menu above will take you to the appropriate screen to record an injury.

The summary screen lists the current status of all required data for this Enhanced Service.

Requirements for payment for this Enhanced Service are:

Minor injury – Enhanced Service claim recorded – (that is the Trigger Code).

And Injury or an onward referral – must be recorded on the same day as the Trigger Code.

For injuries there are numerous screens where any one or more may be recorded. The last link is to an onward referral screen. Making an onward referral will also generate an Enhanced Service claim provided the Trigger Code has also been recorded. On the referral screen you can refer to A & D x-ray orthopaedics ophthalmology or surgical.

The important thing to remember is that an Injury or an onward referral must be recorded on the same day as the Trigger Code in order to qualify for a successful claim.
