

### **Pre-test Clinical Scoring System**

(Modified Well's Criteria, Wells et al. NEJM 2003;349:1227-35)

Active cancer (patient receiving treatment for cancer within the previous 6 months or currently receiving palliative treatment)	<b>1</b>
Paralysis, paresis, or current plaster immobilisation of the lower extremities	<b>1</b>
Recently bedridden for 3 days or more, or major surgery within the previous 12 weeks requiring general or regional anaesthesia	<b>1</b>
Localised tenderness along the distribution of the deep venous system	<b>1</b>
Entire leg swollen	<b>1</b>
Calf swelling at least 3cm larger than that on the asymptomatic side (measured 10cm below tibial tuberosity)	<b>1</b>
Pitting oedema confined to the symptomatic leg	<b>1</b>
Collateral superficial veins (nonvaricose)	<b>1</b>
Previously documented deep-vein thrombosis	<b>1</b>
Alternative diagnosis at least as likely as deep-vein thrombosis	<b>-2</b>

**Score  $\geq$  2: DVT likely**
